


DISASTER RESPONSE

- Local Emergency Planning Committee #12 is dedicated to serving the responders of its 30 member towns in east-central Vermont through planning and preparation activities for incidents of all kinds, and to helping educate the citizens of the region with safety information and tips on emergency preparedness.

What type of activities does the LEPC do?

- Coordinate table top exercises
- Collect, file, and map Tier II facilities to comply with federal mandate
- Generate a regional response plan
- Increase communication between towns and organizations

- VA Hospital, VT 211, Gifford Hospital, Vermont State Police, Vermont Department of Health, Clara Martin Center, Vermont Technical College, Vermont Disaster Animal Response Team... and many more!


- Public Assistance Program (from presidentially declared disasters)


