- 1. Introductions** – Smith called meeting to order 9:30am. Rita roll called attendance.
- Additions to Agenda and Public Comments – none
- 3. Approval of May 12 Minutes** – Bob Moyer moved to approve. Bill Hall seconded. Unanimous approval.
- 4. Transportation Equity Framework** – Dave Pelletier, VTrans & Jonathan Slason, RSG
In 2021 the State Legislature directed the Vermont Agency of Transportation to undertake a comprehensive analysis of the Agency’s existing transportation practices and develop an equity framework to guide all future activities. RPCs are an integral part of this work. This



project is called the Transportation Equity Framework. Dave and Jonathan presented background information and how the framework will be developed with input from RPCs/TACs to be presented to Legislature. Jonathan asked 6 questions to generate discussion on what RPCs are doing/what we can be doing for practices. Some towns have their own Equity and Inclusion committees. 5. **Route 4 Corridor Study – Matthew Arancio, VTrans**

Matthew presented an overview of the Route 4 Corridor study and walked through existing conditions. The Route 4 Corridor study will feed into the future construction project where VTrans will plan to reconstruct Route 4 (no timeframe on schedule right now). Existing conditions discussion included: hot spots for traffic crashes/access management conflicts, truck traffic, culvert drainage assets, shoulder width, the old railroad bed. Matthew discussed timeline for end of December to complete the study and next steps for public engagement. Powerpoint presentation on TRORC TAC website. He welcomes all input on Route 4 corridor.
