Your total household income (for all people living in your home) must be less than or equal to the number listed above for the county where you live AND your household size.

To calculate your income eligibility:

- 1) Gather the 2021 1040 federal tax returns filed by everyone who lives in your home.
- 2) Add up the amounts reported on line 9 (“Total Income”) of each 1040 tax return.
- 3) If the total is less than the threshold established for the number of people in your household (check the chart above for income thresholds), then your business may be eligible for assistance under this program.
