2. Kevin Geiger called the meeting to order at 6:04

3. The December 6, 2023, REMC meeting minutes were approved on a motion by Peter Berger seconded by Alex Northern.

4. Taiga Christie gave a presentation and discussion on the new Large Event Planning Annex that towns can add to the LEMP, and discussed why one might want such, including for the upcoming eclipse. Taiga reviewed past large events and issues raised, such as the Phish concert. Gary Moor provided insights from his experience there. Taiga also shared experiences from other large events. The group discussed common issues such events raise. Norwich and Bradford do have local permitting for large events.

Porta potties have been ordered for rest areas for extra capacity. Any local concerns can be directed to VEM. To get updates from the state during the event, text VTECLIPSE to 888-777.
